Emergency Planning

Whereas, the Portland area is subject to periodic major subduction earthquakes; and

Whereas, these major earthquakes happen on average every 257 years but range between 50 and 350 years apart; and

Whereas, it has been over 300 years since the last major earthquake); and

Whereas, facilities such as the Vaux are subject to other emergency situations such as fire, volcanic eruption, loss of power, gas leaks, etc.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Vaux Condominiums Owners' Association Board of Directors to create an ad hoc planning committee to prepare a recommended emergency preparedness plan for the Board's consideration that encompasses the following elements:

- 1. An assessment of likely emergency risks.
- 2. Identify those that could reasonably benefit from preplanned responses
- 3. Provide identified actions into two categories:
 - a. Association responses in terms of equipment and plans
 - i. Evacuation procedures
 - ii. Congregating location
 - iii. Identifying residents and or pets needing evacuation assistance
 - b. Recommendations for residents for their own preparation
- 4. Identify methods and cycles for communicating the plan to residents oth initially and periodically
- 5. Work to be completed by June 30, 2019
